Situation Summary

French Polynesia remains in a stable security environment with no significant incidents reported in the past 24-48 hours. The territory ranks #189 globally on the GeoBit composite threat index (score: 2) with low violent crime, no active armed conflict, and travel advisories from major governments recommending only routine precautions. Background risks-including petty crime in tourist areas, occasional labor actions, and isolated maritime theft-persist as standing concerns but have not escalated or generated new events in the current reporting window.

Key Developments

- No timestamped new security incidents reported in the past 24-48 hours across French Polynesia's island groups (Windward Islands, Leeward Islands, Marquesas, Tuamotu Archipelago, Austral Islands).
- Official travel advisories (Australia, Canada, United States) remain unchanged, with no new alerts, curfew declarations, or unrest warnings issued since the last 48-hour cycle.
- Papeete and urban marinas continue to experience routine petty crime (pickpocketing, vehicle/boat theft) consistent with historical patterns; no new crime spike or organized activity reported in the last two days.
- Labor and union activity remains at background levels with no confirmed new strikes, demonstrations, or port/road blockades in the past 48 hours.

- Maritime zones (anchorage near Huahine, Uturoa, Bora Bora) show no fresh incidents of vessel boarding, dinghy theft, or harassment in the current window, though intermittent thefts remain a standing concern for cruising vessels.

Highest-Risk Areas

Sub-national risk rankings are currently unavailable in the GeoBit platform. However, Papeete and other urban/tourist concentrations (including marinas and anchorage zones) historically carry elevated petty-crime exposure. Rural and outer-island areas present minimal security risk. Any future escalation would likely center on Papeete's commercial and port districts if labor unrest or economic stress intensifies; maritime zones warrant continued vigilance for opportunistic theft and vessel interference, particularly during low-visibility periods.

How GeoBit Would Assist

A corporate security or duty-of-care team operating in French Polynesia would benefit from AOI Monitoring & Early Warning on Papeete's commercial districts, marinas, and labor-sensitive infrastructure to detect early signals of strikes or civil unrest. OSINT fusion and social-media intelligence (X/Twitter, local forums, and Telegram channels) would provide real-time detection of emerging demonstrations, crime patterns, or maritime incidents before they escalate. Routing & Network Analysis would support contingency planning for staff or asset evacuation or rerouting in the unlikely event of port disruption or civil disorder.

7-Day Outlook

No significant deterioration in security conditions is anticipated over the next seven days. French Polynesia's structural stability-low violent-crime rates, no political instability, and routine governance-suggests continuation of the current calm baseline. Teams should maintain routine vigilance regarding petty crime in tourist and marina areas and monitor local labor calendars for any unscheduled union actions; no specific warnings are warranted at this time.
